We are a Candidate Member School in the Hillsdale College K-12 Charter School Initiative, which provides us with a proven American classical curriculum and extensive, high-quality professional development for our teachers. Our mission is to train the minds and improve the hearts of students through a classical, content-rich curriculum that emphasizes virtuous living, traditional learning, and civic responsibility. Experience with classical education is not required, but successful candidates will be committed to learning and practicing the culture, curriculum, and instructional methods of an American classical school. **Idaho law enables charter schools to certify their own teachers, so teacher certification is not required for initial hire.** We expect to hire and train a faculty cohort made up of individuals with K-12 teaching experience, recent college graduates with a variety of academic backgrounds, and professionals from other fields who are interested in making the transition into American classical education.

Since Idaho Novus Classical Academy is a startup preparing for its inaugural year, this is an incredible opportunity to get involved in the establishment of a new school and lay the groundwork for decades of student success. Opening a school is a fast-paced, demanding, and rewarding experience where you can see the effects of your work every day.
